Please choose 5 from the following:

1. English - write about what you would like to do as a job when you are older. Has anyone inspired you? Why would you choose this job?
2. Art - Draw, paint or collage a picture of a famous person from now or in the past. Why did you choose this person?
3. English - Research and write 5 interesting facts about the Wright brothers.
4. Art - We are looking at sculptures made out of natural materials such as rocks, sand and twigs. Can you make your own sculpture using natural resources? What is the sculpture of? What materials did you use?
5. D.T. - Design and make a rocket to launch into space. What materials would you use? Do you think Neil Armstrong could land it on the moon?
6. Maths - Learn your multiplication and division facts for the 5 times tables.
