Please choose at least 5 from the following:

1. Geography - Design a map of the woods that will lead Hansel and Gretel to the gingerbread house.
2. Art - Imagine that a beanstalk grew in your garden! Draw or paint a picture showing what you would like to find at the top of your beanstalk.
3. Art - Find out about the artist Henri Rousseau. Complete a fact file including when he was born, what happened in his life and what his art work was like.
4. English - Learn a traditional story to tell to the class. Add actions to remember the words.
5. D.T. - In the story of The Elves and the Shoemaker, the shoemaker designs shoes to sell in his shop. Design a new pair of shoes for him to sell.
6. Science - Draw pictures of the 4 different seasons. Can you add to the pictures what happens to the trees? What might you wear during the season?
7. D.T. - In the story of The Gingerbread Man, the little old man and woman follow a recipe to make the gingerbread man. See if you can follow a recipe to make a gingerbread man.
8. Art - In the story of The Three Little Pigs, the wolf blew down two houses. Draw or make a model of a house that would not fall down.
9. Maths - Learn your multiplication and division facts for the 2 times tables.
10. Science - Plant a bean seed, sunflower or cress seeds. What do these seeds need to grow? Complete a diary to show their growth.
11. History - Find out about Florence Nightingale. When was she alive? What did she do? How did she do it?
12. Maths - use Times Table Rockstars to improve your maths skills. Write down what you did and your scores. Remember honesty - I can see at school whether you have been on it!
