General: Read a book for 15 mins each day



This half-term, children can choose at least one activity a week from the list for their homework. They can bring the piece they have completed that week, anytime during that week. This can be stuck into the book or if 3D carried into school!

Children also need to complete Mathletics each week.

Please continue to learn spellings, practise times table facts and read daily throughout the week.

Please choose from the following:

1. English: We are reading Goodnight Mister Tom in school. Write a diary entry from Tom about the day Willie arrives at his home. What might he be feeling? What might be thinking? Does he have anything planned for Willie?
2. Science – In Science this term we are learning about Animals Including Humans. Look at a picture of you as a baby and one of you now, list the similarities and differences. Then look at a picture of a baby animal and one now, again listing the similarities and differences.
3. English – Write the definition and give examples of these key English terms: modal verbs, subordinating conjunctions, co-ordinating conjunctions, fronted adverbials, relative clauses and parenthesis.
4. RE – Show one of our school virtues at home. Send a photo (via dojo) of you being kind, helpful, patient or any of our other virtues. This could be you helping by tidying, washing up, holding a door open. Anything at all really.
5. R.E – During this term we will be completing our Pentecost and Mission unit. Create a symbol for Pentecost. Think about what you have already learnt about Pentecost as well as any new learning. Be prepared to give reasons for your symbolism.
6. History – This term we are learning about the Tudors. We are learning a lot about the lives of Tudor children. Complete some research about Tudor children. Create a poster, non-chronological report or diary entry about a day in the life of a Tudor child.
7. Geography – In Geography we have learnt about both physical and human geographies. Create a poster about Cheltenham identify the physical and human geography.
8. Maths – use TTRockstars to improve your maths skills. Write down what you did and your scores. What would you like further help with?
9. Spanish – This term in Spanish we are learning all about 'The Weekend' using your new Spanish knowledge write a paragraph about what you get up to over the weekend in Spanish.
10. Art/Community Links – Create an illustration/ piece of art work showing our time at Monkscoft Care Centre. You could label it or add a paragraph about your best parts of spending time there.
