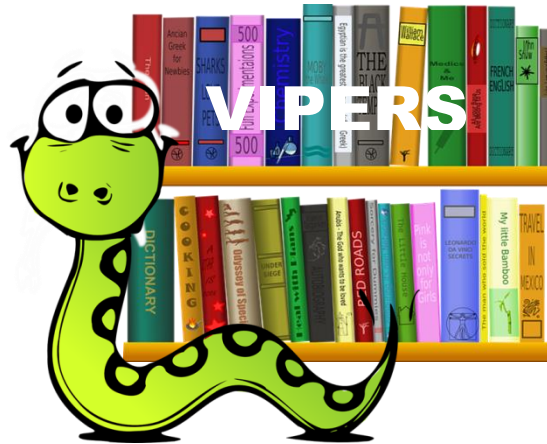


Vocabulary
